In order to be eligible for this award, submit this form with any other required documentation as listed below by the deadline to the Enrolment Services Office at the Welland or Niagara-On-The-Lake Campus.

Eligibility:

The NCSAC President's focus is on leading the organization in a positive direction and motivating others to achieve various goals. This scholarship is for students who have proven leadership skills and have excelled academically, receiving a term average of at least 90% in the most recent academic term.

- Must be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Protected Person
- Must have an average of 90% or higher in the most recent academic term at Niagara College and be currently enrolled
- Leadership skills
- Financial Need (as determined through a current OSAP application, or attach your Funding Summary from another province)
- Current NCSAC Board of Directors Members are not eligible to apply

Ensure you include all required documentation along with your application.

- **A one page statement describing yourself, academic achievements over the past year, and outlining a situation where you showed excellence in leadership. Also describe why you feel you are the best candidate for this scholarship**
- **Reference letter (on letterhead) that reflects your leadership skills and academic achievements**
- **Copy of your Co-curricular record (if available)**
